








Instructions for using Easybib with Google

<p><i>Beginning a New Project</i></p>	
<p>1. In new window select 'New Project'</p>	
<p>3. Name your project and select APA (science) or MLA7 (all others)</p>	
<p>3. Select Create</p>	
<p>4. Project title will appear in list. Under the project title, select Bibliography. (Do not select the Bibliography button at the top, it will not attach to your project.)</p>	 <p style="text-align: center;">You are now ready to begin finding and citing sources.</p>
<p><i>Documenting Sources</i></p>	
<p>1. Open a new tab to begin searching</p>	
<p>2. Type in search words</p>	

<p>3. Once you find a site that you can use for your project select the Red Easybib button on the toolbar.</p>	
<p>4. Select 'cite this'</p>	
<p>5. Fill in blank spaces to complete the citation. You will need to toggle back to your site to find the missing information. (Most of the information will be found at the top of the website or the bottom of the website.)</p>	
<p>6. Once you have completed the blank spaces, click 'Create Citation' at the bottom of the page. Tada! It will be placed with your other sources for the project.</p>
